6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the waste of wild food animals."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.30.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (d) In this section, "most of the edible meat" of a wild food
10 animal means no less than the meat of the front quarters, as far as the
11 juncture of the humerus and the tibia-fibula (elbow), and the meat of
12 the hind quarters, as far as the distal joint of the femur (hock joint),
13 and that portion of the animal between the front and the hind quarters
14 except the innards and the meat of the ribs. However, the following is
15 not considered edible meat:

16 (1) the meat of the head and the neck;

17 (2) any meat that has been damaged and made inedible by the
18 method of taking; and

19 (3) the bones, sinew, and incidental meat reasonably lost as
20 a result of boning or a close trimming of the bones.
