5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the waste of wild food animals."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.30.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (d) In this section, "most of the edible meat" of a wild food
10 animal means no less than the meat of the front quarters, as far as
11 the juncture of the humerus and the radius - ulna (knee), and the
12 meat of the hind quarters, as far as the distal joint of the tibia -
13 fibula (stifle joint) and that portion of the animal between the
14 front and the hind quarters except the viscera and the meat of the
15 ribs. However, the following is not considered edible meat:

16 (1) the meat of the head and the neck;

17 (2) any meat that has been damaged and made inedible by
18 the method of taking; and

19 (3) the bones, sinew, and incidental meat reasonably lost
20 as a result of boning or a close trimming of the bones.
