6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for maintenance reports by aircraft  
7 operating on a scheduled basis within the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 02.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 02.30.035. MAINTENANCE REPORTS. (a) Every owner or operator  
11 of an aircraft licensed to carry more than nine passengers which operates  
12 on a scheduled basis between points within the state shall make at least  
13 four reports each year to the Department of Public Works on days desig-  
14 nated by it and on forms prescribed by it. The reports shall identify  
15 the aircraft operated within the state during the reporting period, the  
16 uncorrected deferred item entries and uncorrected minimum equipment list  
17 item entries carried on the maintenance log of the aircraft at any time  
18 during the period, and the number of days that these items were carried  
19 on the maintenance log uncorrected.

20 (b) All reports shall be published in condensed form at least  
21 once in a newspaper of general circulation published in each judicial  
22 district in which the owner or operator conducted operations on a  
23 scheduled basis during the reporting period.
