6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Arbor Day; and providing for an
7 effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 41.15.400 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 41.15.400. OBSERVANCE OF ARBOR DAY. To increase public
11 awareness of the vital importance of the conservation and propagation of
12 trees and forests to the everyday life of the citizens of Alaska, the
13 third [FIRST] Monday in May of each year is designated "Arbor Day." It
14 shall be observed by appropriate school assemblies and programs and may
15 be the occasion for other suitable observances and exercises by civic
16 groups and the public in general.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
18 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
