For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to authorized removal of a body."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 12.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 12.65.095. REMOVAL OF BODY. (a) A body may not be removed to a mortuary without the express consent of the next of kin or from written instructions by the deceased unless the coroner gives his express authorization.

(b) A person handling the body of a deceased who violates a provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment not to exceed one year or by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by both.
