6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to police security and fire protection
7 at state airports; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 02.15.060 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 02.15.060. ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE. The
11 department may plan, establish, construct, enlarge, improve, maintain,
12 equip, operate, and regulate [, PROTECT AND POLICE] airports and air
13 navigation facilities within the state. However, the functions of
14 police security and fire protection for airports and air navigation
15 facilities shall be provided by the Department of Public Safety.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 18.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17 Sec. 18.65.015. POLICE SECURITY AT STATE AIRPORTS. Police
18 security at airports and air navigation facilities in the state shall
19 be provided by the Department of Public Safety. The Department of
20 Public Safety shall establish standards, uniform requirements, and
21 other regulations necessary for the implementation of this section.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 18.70.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

23 (b) Fire protection at airports and air navigation facilities in
24 the state shall be provided by the Department of Public Safety. The
25 Department of Public Safety shall establish standards and regulations
26 necessary for the implementation of this subsection.

27 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1973.
