For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the penalties for driving under
7 the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.35.030 is amended to read:

Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING

11

LIQUOR OR DRUGS. A person who, while under the influence of intoxi-

12

cating liquor or narcotic drugs, operates or drives an automobile,

13

motorcycle or other motor vehicle in the state upon conviction is

14

punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for

15

not more than one year, or by both, and, additionally, if the person

16

is the owner of a motor vehicle registered in the state, by the

17

issuance of distinctive red license plates which he shall be required

18

to display on the vehicle for a period not to exceed one year. In

19

addition, his operator's license may be limited or suspended in accor-

20

dance with AS 28.15.260(a).
