6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the 'normal retirement date' of
7 public employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.35.680(11) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (11) "normal retirement date" for a peace officer or a fire-
11 man means the first day of the month following either his 50th birthday
12 and five years of credited service or his 20th year of credited service,
13 whichever is earlier, and for any other employee it means the first day
14 of the month following either his 55th birthday and five years of
15 credited service or his 20th year of credited service, whichever is
16 earlier;

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
18 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
