6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to regulations adopted in response
7 to federal requirements."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.62 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.62.025. REGULATIONS RELATED TO FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS.

11 Until the legislature has approved, by concurrent resolution, the
12 agency's proposed regulation, no agency may adopt, in response to
13 federal requirements or in order to participate in a federal program,
14 a regulation setting a standard or requirement more stringent than that
15 specified, if at all, in the pertinent federal law or regulation. This
16 section does not relieve an agency of its duty to comply with the
17 provisions of this chapter, and it does not prohibit an agency from
18 adopting a regulation which merely meets the federal requirements or
19 standards. A regulation adopted before the effective date of this Act,
20 which would violate this section but is otherwise valid, remains valid.
21 A regulation adopted after the effective date of this Act, which
22 violates this section, is void.
