6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the exercise of the power of
7 eminent domain by certain municipalities; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 09.55.240 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (c) Until July 1, 1975, home rule cities of over 50,000 population
12 may exercise eminent domain authority within their boundaries to acquire
13 land for the use of the United States, the State of Alaska or any other
14 political subdivision for governmental office buildings and ancillary
15 improvements, including but not limited to the improvement and land-
16 scaping of adjacent grounds, under an agreement entered into under
17 sec. 13, art. X, Constitution of the State of Alaska.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 09.55.420 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of (a) of this section, until
20 July 1, 1975, a home rule city of over 50,000 population may exercise
21 the power of declaration of taking under sec. 240(c) of this chapter.
22 When the home rule city exercises this power for the United States
23 government, the just compensation paid for the property shall include
24 all relocation and other costs to the extent required by the Uniform
25 Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Act of 1970
26 (P.L. 91-646).

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
