6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bingo, raffles, and ice pools."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 05.15.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 05.15.020. ANNUAL PERMIT AND FEE. (a) No activity per-
10 mitted under this chapter may be conducted unless an annual permit
11 issued by the department is first obtained. No activity is permitted
12 for a period of 15 days after application.

13 (b) The permit fee is \$40 plus a sum equal to 10 per cent of the
14 gross receipts from the permitted activity.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 05.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

16 Sec. 05.15.190. RETURN OF PERMIT FEES TO MUNICIPALITY. (a) The
17 legislature may appropriate each year to each municipality an amount
18 equal to the net revenue to the state under sec. 20 of this chapter
19 raised from permitted activities under this chapter in the municipality.

20 (b) The commission shall submit to the legislature each session
21 a report including the total fees collected under sec. 20 of this
22 chapter by the state for the preceding calendar year, the total cost
23 of administering this chapter, and the average administration cost as
24 a percentage of the total permit fees.

25 (c) Appropriations to municipalities shall be computed by deduct-
26 ing from the total permit fees collected for permitted activities in
27 the municipality the average percentage of administration costs under
28 (b) of this section.

29 (d) Appropriations to municipalities under this section shall

1 be used by the municipalities for recreational activities and purposes.
