6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to correspondence study; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.07 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 14.07.035. DIVISION OF CORRESPONDENCE STUDIES. (a) There  
11 is created within the department the division of correspondence studies  
12 to provide early childhood, elementary, secondary and postsecondary  
13 education by means of correspondence.

14 (b) The division of correspondence studies shall administer the  
15 state program of correspondence education by

16 (1) developing, screening and obtaining appropriate basic  
17 and supplemental instructional materials and aids for the levels of  
18 education set out in (a) of this section; and

19 (2) providing for visitations to assist enrolled correspon-  
20 dence students when necessary.

21 (c) Appropriations to the department for the division of corre-  
22 spondence studies shall be supplemented by

23 (1) contributions from school districts directly to the  
24 department for deposit in the correspondence study revolving fund on  
25 the basis of courses enrolled in by correspondence students residing  
26 in a city or borough school district; or

27 (2) legislative appropriations equal to one-third of the  
28 average per pupil expenditure in the unorganized borough during the  
29 prefiscal year for each enrolled correspondence student residing in the

1 unorganized borough.

2       Sec. 14.07.037. CORRESPONDENCE STUDY REVOLVING FUND. There is  
3 created a correspondence study revolving fund as an account in the  
4 general fund. The fund shall be used to pay the cost of administration  
5 of the correspondence study program under sec. 35 of this chapter,  
6 including but not limited to the replacement and updating of instruc-  
7 tional materials and aids under sec. 35(b)(1) of this chapter. All  
8 school district contributions and all legislative appropriations for  
9 the administration of the correspondence study program under sec. 35(c)  
10 of this chapter shall be deposited in the correspondence study revolving  
11 fund.

12 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1974.
