6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Guide Licensing and Control
7 Board; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.54 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 08.54.043. ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY DUTIES. The
11 Department of Fish and Game shall provide, when necessary, adminis-
12 trative and budgetary services as specified in AS 08.01.050 to the
13 Guide Licensing and Control Board. Appropriate administrative and
14 budgetary duties not specified in AS 08.01.050 but which are necessary
15 to the operation of the board shall be performed by the Department of
16 Fish and Game.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 08.54.210(b) is amended to read:

18 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
19 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000
20 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both, and may have
21 his license revoked for a period up to five years. However, a person
22 who engages in [OUTFITTING OR] guiding activity during the period
23 his license is suspended or revoked under [OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION
24 UNDER SEC. 200(e) OF] this chapter is guilty of a felony punishable,
25 upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or [AND] by imprison-
26 ment for not less than one year nor more than three years, or by both
27 fine and imprisonment. In addition to punishment for a felony [UNDER
28 SEC. 200 (e) OF THIS CHAPTER], all guns, fishing tackle, boats, air-
29 craft, automobiles or other vehicles, camping gear and other equipment

1 and paraphernalis used in, or in aid of, guiding activity engaged
2 in during the period of suspension or revocation [A VIOLATION OF
3 SEC. 200(e) OF THIS CHAPTER] shall be confiscated by persons authorized
4 to enforce this chapter.

5 * Sec. 3. AS 08.54.220 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 08.54.220. INJUNCTION AGAINST UNLAWFUL ACTION. When in
7 the judgment of the board a person or corporation or other entity
8 has engaged in an act in violation of sec. 130 and secs. 200 - 210
9 [SECS. 100 - 200] of this chapter or the regulations promulgated
10 under them [SEC. 210 OF THIS CHAPTER], the board may apply to the
11 appropriate court for an order enjoining the act. Upon a showing by
12 the board that the person is engaging in the act, the court shall
13 grant injunctive relief or other appropriate order without bond.

14 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
15 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
