6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to administrative leave for employees
7 engaged in collective bargaining; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.40.080 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (b) Public employees chosen or elected to represent employees
12 in a bargaining unit are entitled to administrative leave for each
13 day of travel to and from the place of bargaining and for each day
14 spent in the bargaining process. No more than six employees for each
15 bargaining team may be granted administrative leave at one time.

16 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
17 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
