6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid to local governments for
7 police protection; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.18.010(a)(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) \$12 [\$10] per capita to cities and boroughs providing
11 police protection, subject to the conditions of this paragraph and (g)
12 of this section;

13 (A) municipal police protection shall be available 24
14 hours a day;

15 (B) municipal police officers shall be U.S. citizens
16 who are at least 19 years of age and who have not been convicted of
17 a crime involving moral turpitude within the past 10 years;

18 * Sec. 2. AS 43.18.010(c) is amended to read:

19 (c) For purposes of this section, population shall be determined by
20 the latest figures of the United States Bureau of the Census or other
21 reliable populations data, including but not limited to public school
22 enrollment figures, public utility connection, registered voters or
23 certified employment payrolls.

24 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1974.
