6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to platting powers of municipalities."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 29.33 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 29.33.155. DEDICATION OF PARK, OPEN SPACE, RECREATION LANDS.

10 (a) A borough which has acquired power as otherwise provided in this
11 title to provide parks and other recreational land and facilities, in
12 the area in which it has acquired the power, may, by ordinance, require
13 the dedication of land, the payment of fees instead of dedication, or a
14 combination of both, for parks, open space or recreational purposes as a
15 condition of the approval of a final subdivision plat; however,

16 (1) the ordinance shall include definite standards for
17 determining the proportion of a subdivision to be dedicated and the
18 amount of any fee to be paid instead of dedication;

19 (2) the amount and location of land to be dedicated or the
20 fees to be paid shall bear a reasonable relationship to the use of the
21 land or recreational facilities placed on the land by future inhabitants
22 of the subdivision, and the borough shall provide for the management
23 and maintenance of the park and recreational land dedicated;

24 (3) if a fee is to be paid to the borough under this
25 section instead of dedication of land, the fee shall become payable at
26 the rate that the lots or tracts of the subdivision planned for sale are
27 sold.

28 (b) The land dedicated and fees paid under (a) of this section
29 shall be used only for the purpose of providing park, recreation or

1 open space facilities.

2 * Sec. 2. AS 40.15.030 is amended to read:

3 Sec. 40.15.030. DEDICATION OF STREETS, ALLEYS, [AND] THOROUGH-
4 FARES AND OTHER PUBLIC AREAS. When an area is subdivided and a plat
5 of the subdivision is approved and recorded, all streets, alleys,
6 thoroughfares, parks and other public areas marked and shown on the
7 plat are considered [DEEMED] to have been dedicated to public use.
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
