6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative per diem; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.15.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 24.15.010. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. (a) The rate of per diem
11 instead of subsistence for each member of the legislature permanently re-
12 siding more than 35 miles from the capital city who is in travel status
13 and away from home overnight is \$35 for each day of a legislative
14 session. The per diem is also payable for those days of necessary
15 travel to and from sessions. All other legislators are entitled to
16 receive \$15 for each day of a legislative session.

17 (b) Legislators who are on official legislative business between
18 sessions at locations more than 35 miles from their permanent residence
19 and who are in travel status and away from home overnight are entitled
20 to receive \$35 for each day or portion of a day spent on official
21 business. The per diem is also payable for those days of necessary
22 travel to and from the location where the business is required to be
23 conducted. All other legislators who are on official business between
24 sessions are entitled to \$15 a day or portion of a day spent on official
25 business.

26 * Sec. 2. The provisions of sec. 1 of this Act are retroactive to
27 January 1, 1974.

28 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
29 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
