6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative per diem; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 24.15.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 24.15.010. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. (a) All legislators who  
11 permanently reside within 35 miles of the capital city shall receive  
12 \$15 as the rate of per diem instead of subsistence for each day of the  
13 legislative session. All other legislators who permanently reside  
14 more than 35 miles from the capital city, who are on travel status and  
15 away from home overnight shall receive \$35 as the rate of per diem for  
16 each day of the legislative session. The \$35 per diem is also payable  
17 for each day of necessary travel to and from sessions for legislators  
18 who reside more than 35 miles from the capital city.

19 (b) Legislators who are on official legislative business between  
20 sessions and who are on travel status and away from home overnight  
21 more than 35 miles from where they permanently reside shall receive  
22 \$35 per diem. Legislators who are on official legislative business  
23 between sessions but within 35 miles of where they permanently reside  
24 shall receive \$15 per diem. The \$35 per diem is also payable on those  
25 days of necessary travel to and from the location where legislative  
26 business is required to be conducted.

27 \* Sec. 2. The provisions of sec. 1 of this Act are retroactive to  
28 January 1, 1974.

29 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval

1 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
