6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to assault or assault and battery  
7 on a peace officer, correction officer or a  
8 fireman."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 11.15.225. ASSAULT OR ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON CERTAIN  
12 OFFICIALS. (a) A person who strikes or wounds a peace officer,  
13 correction officer or fireman while these persons are performing their  
14 official duties is guilty of a felony and upon conviction is punishable  
15 by imprisonment in the penitentiary for not less than two nor more  
16 than five years.

17 (b) The minimum sentence provided for in (a) of this section is  
18 mandatory and the discretionary provisions of AS 11.05.150, AS 12.55.080,  
19 12.55.085 and 12.55.090 do not apply to sentencing for the crime set out  
20 in (a) of this section.
