6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to permits for the use of armed  
7 guards; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 23.10.025 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 23.10.025. USE OF ARMED GUARDS. A person who, in this  
11 state, hires persons to guard other persons or property in this state  
12 with arms or deadly weapons, or a person who comes into this state  
13 armed with deadly weapons for the purpose of guarding other persons  
14 or property without a written permit from the commissioner of public  
15 safety [GOVERNOR] is guilty of a felony, and upon conviction is  
16 punishable by imprisonment in a jail for not less than one year nor  
17 more than five years.

18 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
19 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
