6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to permits for the use of armed
7 guards; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.10.025 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 23.10.025. USE OF ARMED GUARDS. (a) A person who, in this
11 state, hires persons to guard [OTHER] persons or property in this
12 state with arms or deadly weapons, or a person who comes into this
13 state armed with deadly weapons for the purpose of guarding [OTHER]
14 persons or property without a written permit from the commissioner of
15 public safety [GOVERNOR] is guilty of a felony, and upon conviction is
16 punishable by imprisonment in a jail for not less than one year nor
17 more than five years.

18 (b) While on duty, a person working as an armed guard shall,
19 after January 1, 1976, wear a uniform of a color other than that of the
20 Alaska State Troopers or Local Municipal Police.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
22 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
