5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$10,500,000 for the
8 purpose of paying the cost of fish and game management,
9 development and enforcement facilities; and providing
10 for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of fish and game manage-
13 ment, development, and enforcement facilities, general obligation bonds of
14 the state in the principal amount of \$10,500,000 shall be issued and sold.
15 The full faith, credit and resources of the state are pledged to the payment
16 of the principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on these
17 bonds. These bonds shall be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as
18 those provisions read at the time of issuance.

19 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
20 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1974
21 Fish and Game Management, Development and Enforcement Facilities Construction
22 Fund" shall be established, to which shall be credited the proceeds of the
23 sale of the bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act except for the accrued
24 interest and premiums. There is appropriated from the "1974 Fish and Game
25 Management, Development and Enforcement Facilities Construction Fund" to the
26 Department of Fish and Game the amount of \$10,500,000. Notwithstanding the
27 provisions of AS 24.30.037, the governor shall allocate an amount to each
28 project from the proceeds of these bonds. However, in accordance with
29 AS 24.30.037, the specific uses of the proceeds of these bonds shall be

1 for projects at the locations set out as follows:

- 2 (1) Petersburg - Crystal Lake hatchery
- 3 (2) Ketchikan - purchase new vessel
- 4 (3) Southcentral fish hatchery construction
- 5 (4) Homer - purchase new vessel
- 6 (5) Haines - fish counting system
- 7 (6) Bristol Bay - smolt sonar equipment
- 8 (7) Southeast king salmon egg take system
- 9 (8) Southeast vessel acquisition
- 10 (9) Holitna River salmon counting weir
- 11 (10) Fire Lake Hatchery wastewater treatment
- 12 (11) fish transport unit for stocking
- 13 (12) hydro-acoustical gear and boat
- 14 (13) Kenai - rear, capture and transport system
- 15 (14) Kitoi Bay - hatchery repairs
- 16 (15) Kachemak - vessel acquisition
- 17 (16) Anvik River salmon counting weir
- 18 (17) Prince William Sound incubation system
- 19 (18) Kachemak Bay incubation system
- 20 (19) Southeast - gravel incubation facility
- 21 (20) Southeast fish ladders
- 22 (21) Anchorage and Kodiak - purchase public access
- 23 (22) Unga Island - Apollo Creek fish ladder
- 24 (23) Pavlov Bay - Middle Creek fish ladders
- 25 (24) Sitka - gravel incubation facility
- 26 (25) gravel incubation facilities:
 - 27 (A) Southeast
 - 28 (B) Prince William Sound
 - 29 (C) Kodiak

- 1 (D) Cook Inlet
- 2 (E) Southwestern
- 3 (F) Interior

4 * Sec. 3. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
5 voters of the state, the amount of \$36,750 or as much of that amount as is
6 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
7 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay
8 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
9 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
10 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of
11 the bonds authorized by this Act.

12 * Sec. 4. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
13 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the
14 next state general election and shall read substantially as follows:

15 Proposition

16 State General Obligation Fish and Game Management,
17 Development and Enforcement Facilities Bonds \$10,500,000
18 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation bonds
19 in the principal amount of \$10,500,000 for the purpose of
20 paying the cost of constructing fish and game management, develop-
21 ment and enforcement facilities?

24 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
25 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
