5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state aid to local governments for
7 fire protection; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.18.010(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) \$7.50 [\$5] per capita to cities and boroughs providing
11 fire protection;

12 (A) fire protection includes, but is not limited to,
13 fire protection provided by a volunteer fire department registered
14 with the state fire marshal which has official recognition and
15 financial support from the city or borough in which it is located;

16 (B) in addition to the grants authorized under this
17 section, the state shall pay to a volunteer fire department
18 registered with the state fire marshal and serving an area not in
19 an organized borough or a city a sum for protection purposes equal
20 to \$7.50 [\$5] per capita for the population served by the depart-
21 ment, as determined by the state fire marshal using the latest
22 figures of the United States Bureau of the Census or other reliable
23 data; grants shall be made on the same basis to facilitate the
24 organization of volunteer fire departments in an area not in an
25 organized borough or a city, upon application of the proposed fire
26 protection group to the state fire marshal and approval of applica-
27 tions according to standards of organization and service prescribed
28 by regulations promulgated by the state fire marshal;

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1974.
