6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to release on parole; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 33.15.080 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 33.15.080. GRANTING OF PAROLE. If it appears to the board
11 from a review that a prisoner eligible for parole will, in reasonable
12 probability, live and remain at liberty without violating the laws, or
13 without violating the conditions imposed by the board, and if the
14 board determines that his release on parole is not incompatible with
15 the welfare of society, the board may authorize the release of the
16 prisoner on parole. However, no prisoner may be released on parole
17 who has not served at least one-third of the sentence imposed, unless
18 the judge who sentenced the prisoner approves an earlier release. If
19 the sentencing judge is not available because of death, illness,
20 absence from the state or because he is no longer in office, the
21 presiding judge of the judicial district where sentence was imposed
22 shall approve or disapprove the release.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
24 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
