6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the commission of a felony while
7 released on bail; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 12.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 12.30.065. COMMITTING A FELONY WHILE RELEASED ON BAIL ON
11 ANOTHER FELONY CHARGE. A person who is convicted of committing an
12 offense punishable as a felony, whether state or federal, and that
13 offense was committed while that person is released on bail, on his
14 own recognizance, or on his unsecured appearance bond, on another,
15 separate felony charge, is guilty of committing a felony while re-
16 leased on bail, provided that he is convicted on the initial felony
17 charge, and upon conviction shall be sentenced to imprisonment for not
18 less than five years to life. That penalty is in addition to, and, as
19 prescribed in AS 11.05.050, shall be served consecutively to, any
20 penalty imposed for an offense punishable as a felony committed while
21 released on bail.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
23 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
