6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to juries, harmonizing the Alaska  
7 Statutes with Alaska Supreme Court Civil Rule 47(f)  
8 and Criminal Rule 23(b); and providing for an effec-  
9 tive date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 09.20.090 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 09.20.090. IMPANELING THE TRIAL JURY. When a civil case  
13 which is to be tried by a jury is called for trial, the clerk shall  
14 draw from the trial jury box containing the names of those on the jury  
15 panel a number of names or numbers sufficient to name a jury of 12  
16 unless the parties have stipulated in writing with the approval  
17 of the court that the jury shall consist of a number equal to at  
18 least six but less than 12 [COURT DIRECTS OTHERWISE]. The prospective  
19 jurors shall be examined, challenged, and sworn as provided by rules  
20 of the supreme court.

21 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
22 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
