6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to persons incapacitated by alcohol."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 47.37.270(8) is amended to read:

9 (8) "incapacitated by alcohol" means a person who is un-
10 conscious or has his judgment otherwise so impaired that he is incapable
11 of realizing and making a rational decision with respect to his need
12 for treatment, or a person who is extremely physically debilitated or
13 exerting [AS EVIDENCED OBJECTIVELY BY EXTREME PHYSICAL DEBILITATION,]
14 physical harm or threats of harm to others [OR CHRONIC INABILITY TO
15 HOLD REGULAR EMPLOYMENT];
