6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the harboring of minors evading  
7 legal custody."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 47.10.144. HARBORING MINOR EVADING LEGAL CUSTODY. (a) No  
11 person may harbor, shield or otherwise detain a minor whom he knows is  
12 evading the person having legal custody over him without notifying,  
13 within 48 hours from the time he knows of the evasion of custody,  
14 either (1) the person having legal custody over him, (2) the Department  
15 of Health and Social Services, or (3) a peace officer.

16 (b) A person who violates (a) of this section, is guilty of a  
17 misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more  
18 than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both.
