6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the grading and content of the  
7 state pharmacy examination."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.80.120. is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.80.120. GRADING AND CONTENT OF EXAMINATION. To pass the  
11 state pharmacy examination each applicant must attain a general average  
12 of not less than 75 per cent and a grade of not less than 60 per cent  
13 in any one category of the National Association of Board of Pharmacy  
14 Standard Examinations for licensure or an equivalent examination given  
15 by the board [EACH OF THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS ON THE EXAMINATION:  
16 JURISPRUDENCE, CHEMISTRY, MATHEMATICS, PHARMACY, PHARMACOLOGY AND  
17 RELATED SUBJECTS, AND IN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, ORAL THEORY AND  
18 PRACTICAL PHARMACY].
