6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to districts for the election of
7 school board members; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.23.310 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 29.23.310. ELECTION. Each borough and city school district
12 has a school board. Members are elected at the regular election held
13 annually on the first Tuesday of October, unless a different election
14 date or interval of years is provided by ordinance, for three-year
15 terms and until their successors take office. Unless otherwise pro-
16 vided by ordinance, all [ALL] board members are elected at large, but
17 school districts [ZONES] for the election of members of borough school
18 boards may be established, altered, or abolished by ordinance ratified
19 by the voters at a regular or special election [AS PROVIDED BY SEC.
20 100 OF THIS CHAPTER].

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
22 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
