6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of certain enter-
7 tainment in places where alcoholic beverages are sold;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 04.15.095. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN ENTERTAINMENT IN CONNEC-
12 TION WITH SALE OF BEVERAGES ON LICENSED PREMISES. (a) No holder of
13 a license issued under this title may employ or permit, nor may a li-
14 cense be issued to any person who employs or permits, any person,
15 whether or not compensation is paid to that person as a waiter, waitress
16 or entertainer, to perform any live act, exhibition or demonstration,
17 commonly known as "topless" or "bottomless", that involves exposure
18 of the genitals, buttocks or breasts of any participant.

19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of sec. 70 of this chapter,
20 an ordinance adopted by the governing body of a municipality that
21 relates to live acts, demonstrations or exhibitions which are prohibited
22 under (a) of this section is invalid. It is the intention of the
23 legislature in enacting this section to pre-empt the entire field.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
25 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
