6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the qualifications of an assistant
7 adjutant general; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 26.05.180(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The headquarters of the Alaska National Guard is composed of
11 an Army National Guard component, an Air National Guard component and a
12 Naval Militia component. The Army National Guard component and the Air
13 National Guard component shall each be commanded by an assistant
14 adjutant general appointed by the adjutant general with the concurrence
15 of the governor. An assistant adjutant general shall, while holding
16 office, have the grade of brigadier general or a lower grade which the
17 adjutant general may prescribe. [ON INITIAL APPOINTMENT AN ASSISTANT
18 ADJUTANT GENERAL MUST HOLD A FEDERALLY-RECOGNIZED FIELD-GRADE
19 COMMISSION WITH AT LEAST FIVE YEARS SERVICE IN THE ALASKA ARMY NATIONAL
20 GUARD OR IN THE ALASKA AIR NATIONAL GUARD.]

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
22 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
