6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of dump-type
7 equipment; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.10.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (5) motor vehicles operated by a person while transporting
11 commodities in bulk in dump-type equipment except that weight fees in
12 the amount provided for in sec. 240 of this chapter shall be paid, and
13 insurance or deposit of security as provided for in sec. 190 of this
14 chapter shall be required for each vehicle operated on a public highway.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 42.10.420(12) is amended to read:

16 (12) "construction contractor" means a contractor licensed by
17 the state as a general contractor under AS 08.18 to engage in and who
18 is actively and regularly engaged in the business of constructing, re-
19 pairing or removing any kind of private or public facility or structure
20 [AND DOES NOT INCLUDE "CONTRACT CARRIERS" AUTHORIZED TO TRANSPORT
21 COMMODITIES IN BULK IN DUMP-TYPE EQUIPMENT UNLESS THE "CONTRACT CARRIER"
22 IS ALSO ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING
23 OR REMOVING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC FACILITIES OR STRUCTURES AS A LICENSED
24 GENERAL CONTRACTOR UNDER AS 08.18].

25 * Sec. 3. AS 42.10.280(a) is repealed.

26 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
27 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
