6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle safety responsi-
7 bility; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.20.050(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The provisions of this chapter requiring deposit of
11 security and suspension for failure to deposit security apply to the
12 driver and owner of a vehicle subject to registration under the laws
13 of this state which is involved in any manner in an accident in
14 this state resulting in bodily injury to or death of a person or
15 damage to the property of any one person exceeding \$400 [\$200].

16 * Sec. 2. AS 28.20.100(c) is amended to read:

17 (c) If the department evaluates the injuries or damage to a
18 minor in an amount not more than \$400 [\$200], the department may
19 accept, for the purposes of this chapter only, evidence of a release
20 from liability executed by a natural or legal guardian on behalf of
21 the minor without court approval.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 28.20.230(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) The provisions of this chapter requiring the deposit of
24 proof of financial responsibility for the future apply to persons who
25 are convicted of or forfeit bail for certain offenses under motor
26 vehicle laws or who, by ownership or operation of a vehicle of a type
27 subject to registration under the motor vehicle laws of this state,
28 are involved in an accident in this state which results in bodily
29 injury or death of a person or damage to the property of any one

1 person exceeding \$400 [\$200].

2 * Sec. 4. AS 28.20.260(a) is amended to read:

3 (a) Upon receipt by the department of the report of an accident
4 resulting in bodily injury or death, or property damage to the extent
5 of \$400 [\$200] or more, the department shall suspend the license of
6 the operator of a motor vehicle involved in the accident unless the
7 operator or owner

8 (1) has previously furnished or immediately furnishes
9 security required by this chapter, or is excepted from furnishing
10 security under sec. 60 of this chapter, and

11 (2) maintains proof of financial responsibility for three
12 years following the accident.

13 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
14 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
