5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to creditable service for teachers."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 14.25.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (d) Credit for service in the armed forces shall be granted for  
10 up to four years if a teacher's entrance into the teaching profession  
11 was delayed due to military service. This delay may be either before,  
12 during, or immediately after finishing college. The teacher, in order  
13 to obtain credit under this subsection, shall make contributions to  
14 the system in the same manner as required for outside service under  
15 sec. 60 of this chapter.
