6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the conveyance of public recrea-
7 tional sites."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 38.05.323. TIDELANDS SEAWARD OF PUBLIC RECREATIONAL SITES.

11 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a home rule or general
12 law municipality which accepts by conveyance or other disposition from
13 the state a public recreation area facility developed under the terms
14 of P.L. 507 (70 Stat. 130), upon application, shall receive by conveyance
15 from the director all land owned by the state seaward of the public
16 recreation area facility which is between the mean high tide line and
17 the mean low tide line. The director may promulgate necessary regula-
18 tions providing for the conveyance of land under this section.

19 (b) Interests obtained by lease for shore fisheries development,
20 sale, permit or lease for mineral exploration, development, or extrac-
21 tion, or for any other purpose, before the effective date of this Act,
22 are affected by the provisions of this Act only on the date of their
23 expiration or termination.
