6 For an Act entitled: "An Act allowing certain compensation for sick leave."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 39.20.260(e) is amended to read:

9 (e) Upon his separation from state service, and unless he re-
10 enters employment of the state within six months of his termination,
11 the unused sick leave of an officer or employee is automatically
12 cancelled without pay for it. However, accumulated sick leave is to
13 be counted in determining service credit under ch. 35 of this title.
14 If an officer or employee when terminated by the state re-enters the
15 state service within six months after his termination he is entitled
16 to credit for one-half of the sick leave he had accrued at the time of
17 his termination.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 39.35.300 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 39.35.300. EMPLOYMENT WITH THE STATE. An employee is en-
20 titled to service credit for the entire period of uninterrupted employ-
21 ment with the state for which he makes contributions required by this
22 chapter beginning January 1, 1961, or the latest date the employee
23 entered employment, whichever is later, and ending with the termination
24 of his employment, regardless of the office, department, division, or
25 agency of the state in which he was employed and for accumulated sick
26 leave.
