6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the definition of 'commercial
7 fisherman' under the Fish and Game Code (AS 16.05);
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.940(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) "commercial fisherman" means an individual who fishes
12 commercially for, takes, or attempts to take fish, shellfish, or other
13 fishery resources of the state by any means, and includes every indi-
14 vidual aboard a boat operated for fishing purposes who participates
15 directly or indirectly in the taking of these raw fishery products,
16 whether participation is on shares or as an employee or otherwise;
17 however, this definition does not apply to anyone aboard a licensed
18 vessel as a visitor or guest who does not directly or indirectly
19 participate in the taking, or to the wife of a commercial fisherman
20 who does not receive income separate and distinct from that of her
21 husband as a result of her participation, or minor child or other
22 dependent minor of a commercial fisherman who does not receive income
23 separate and distinct from that of the commercial fisherman as a result
24 of the minor child's or dependent minor's participation; and the term
25 "commercial fisherman" includes the crews of tenders or other floating
26 craft used in transporting fish;

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
