6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to extension of state jurisdiction
7 over natural resources."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.907. EXTENSION OF RESOURCE JURISDICTION. Notwith-
11 standing any other provision of law, for the purpose of ownership and
12 control of the living resources of the sea, the jurisdiction of the
13 state extends to and over, and is exercisable with respect to, waters
14 offshore from its coastline for a distance of 200 miles or to the
15 furthest edge of the continental shelf, whichever is greater;
