6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the discharge of firearms; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.55.065 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.55.065. SHOOTING FROM, ON, OR ACROSS HIGHWAYS. A person
11 who discharges a firearm from, on, or across a highway or its right-of-
12 way up to a distance of 25 feet from either side of the driveable
13 surface of a highway, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction
14 is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in
15 jail for not more than one year, or by both. In this section "highway"
16 means all highways [(WHETHER OR NOT] included in federal-aid interstate,
17 primary or secondary systems. Roads, [], ROADS, ROAD] rights-of-way,
18 [STREETS,] public trails, walks, bridges, tunnels and other similar or
19 related structures or facilities are not included in the definition of
20 highways unless the Department of Fish and Game, after consultation with
21 the Department of Public Safety, declares by regulation that the public's
22 safety requires that they be defined as highways for the purposes of
23 this section.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
25 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
