6 For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting police employees from the Public
7 Employment Relations Act."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.40.080 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 23.40.080. RIGHTS OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES. Except for police
11 employees, public [PUBLIC] employees may self-organize and form, join
12 or assist an organization to bargain collectively through representa-
13 tives of their own choosing, and engage in concerted activities for the
14 purpose of collective bargaining or other mutual aid or protection.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 23.40.200(b) is amended to read:

16 (b) The class in (a)(1) of this section is composed of [POLICE
17 AND] fire protection employees, jail, prison and other correctional
18 institution employees, and hospital employees. Employees in this class
19 may not engage in strikes. Upon a showing by a public employer or the
20 labor relations agency that employees in this class are engaging or
21 about to engage in a strike, an injunction, restraining order, or other
22 order which may be appropriate shall be granted by the superior court
23 in the judicial district in which the strike is occurring or is about
24 to occur. If an impasse or deadlock is reached in collective bargaining
25 between the public employer and employees in this class, and mediation
26 has been utilized without resolving the deadlock, the parties shall
27 submit to arbitration to be carried out under AS 09.43.030.

29 (5) "public employee" means any employee of a public employer,

1 whether or not in the classified service of the public employer,
2 except elected or appointed officials or teachers or noncertificated
3 employees of school districts or police employees;
