6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to records kept by the lieutenant
7 governor under the Federal Election Campaign Act;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.19.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 44.19.030. DUTIES OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR. The lieuten-
12 ant governor shall

13 (1) administer state election laws,

14 (2) appoint notaries public,

15 (3) receive, maintain and preserve reports which are required

16 to be filed by candidates under the Federal Election Campaign Act of
17 1971 (4 U.S.C. secs. 431 - 454 (1970 Ed, supp II), as amended) and
18 do so in the manner prescribed under sec. 439 of that Act; and, within
19 14 days from the date of receipt of the reports, prepare and make
20 available upon request a summary of those reports, summarizing the
21 following information by each candidate, for all candidates who are
22 reported to the lieutenant governor:

23 (A) the name and address of each person or political
24 committee contributing more than \$500 to that candidate,

25 (B) the name and address of the 10 persons or political
26 committees who contributed the most money to that candidate,

27 (C) as much information as is available to the lieuten-
28 ant governor about the political committees which are listed in
29 (A) or (B) of this paragraph.

1 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
2 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
