2 HOUSE BILL NO. 743

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the definition of 'employee' in  
7 the state public employees' retirement system."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.35.680(5) is amended to read:

10 (5) "employee"

11 (A) means a person who receives remuneration for full-  
12 time, part-time or temporary personal services [REGULARLY] rendered  
13 to an employer or who would receive remuneration except for an  
14 authorized leave of absence;

15 (B) means an elected official currently serving who  
16 elects to pay contributions required of an employee and to be  
17 included in the system under sec. 125 of this chapter; for  
18 purposes of this paragraph a state legislator is considered to  
19 be a full-time elected official;

20 (C) does not include

21 (i) persons compensated on a contractual or free  
22 basis,

23 [(ii) CASUAL OR PART-TIME WORKERS IN A POSITION  
24 HAVING DUTIES WHICH WILL NOT PERMIT AT LEAST SIX MONTHS OF  
25 SERVICE DURING A CALENDAR YEAR,]

26 (iii) persons covered by the Alaska teachers' retire-  
27 ment system,

28 (iv) employees of the division of marine transporta-  
29 tion engaged in operating the state ferry system who are

1 covered by a union or group retirement system to which the  
2 state makes contributions, and

3 (v) justices and judges of the supreme, superior  
4 and district courts of Alaska;
