6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the concealment of merchandise."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 09.65.110. CIVIL LIABILITY FOR CONCEALMENT OF MERCHANDISE.

A person who wilfully conceals goods or merchandise from a merchant's  
11 premises, in addition to any criminal penalty provided by law, is  
12 liable in a civil action to the merchant for damages of not less than  
13 \$100 or more than \$250, or in the case of goods or merchandise having  
14 a retail value in excess of \$250, for the full retail value of the  
15 goods or merchandise. In addition, the person violating this section  
16 is liable for all costs and reasonable attorney fees involved in the  
17 action.
