6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to interstate acquisition of criminal  
7 justice information; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 12.62.030(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) Except as provided in (b) and (c) of this section, and in  
12 accordance with sec. 50(c) of this chapter, access to specified classes  
13 of criminal justice information in criminal justice information systems  
14 is available only to individual law enforcement agencies according to  
15 the specific needs of the agency under regulations established by the  
16 commission under sec. 10 of this chapter. Criminal justice information  
17 may be used only for law enforcement purposes or for those additional  
18 lawful purposes necessary to the proper enforcement or administration of  
19 other provisions of law as the commission may prescribe by regulations  
20 established under sec. 10 of this chapter. No criminal justice informa-  
21 tion may be disseminated to an agency before the commission determines  
22 the agency's eligibility to receive that information.

23 \* Sec. 2. AS 12.62.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

24 (c) No law enforcement agency of this state may furnish criminal  
25 justice information to, nor permit access to the Alaska Justice Informa-  
26 tion System by a law enforcement agency which does not provide for  
27 the security, updating, correcting and purging of criminal justice infor-  
28 mation in a way comparable to or more efficient than the safeguards  
29 required by this chapter.

1 \* Sec. 3. Under the supervision of the commission, law enforcement  
2 agencies of the state shall review their records to determine which out-  
3 of-state agencies have acquired criminal justice information before the  
4 effective date of this Act which would be contrary to AS 12.62.050(c)  
5 if acquired after the effective date of this Act. The commission, in  
6 conjunction with Alaska agencies, shall then inform the other jurisdictions  
7 of the prohibition in AS 12.62.050(c) and shall make every reasonable  
8 effort to have the information purged by agencies in other jurisdictions  
9 which fail to provide the safeguards required by AS 12.62.

10 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1974.

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
