6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the installation of fire detectors  
7 in residential dwellings."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.70 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 18.70.081. FIRE DETECTORS; REQUIRED IN RESIDENCES. After  
11 December 31, 1974, combustion fire detectors shall be installed in the  
12 sleeping areas of each single-family dwelling built, constructed,  
13 assembled in, or transported into, the state for use as a residence.  
14 After December 31, 1975, the provisions of this section apply to the  
15 sleeping areas in each unit of a multiple-family dwelling that is built,  
16 constructed, assembled in, or transported into, the state for use as a  
17 residence. The combustion fire detector device installed in these  
18 dwelling units shall be a type that is approved either by the Under-  
19 writer Laboratories or Factory Mutual. For the purpose of this section  
20 "dwelling unit" or "residence" includes, but is not limited to, a  
21 mobile home, modular home, or other unit or form of prefabricated  
22 dwelling used for a residence.
