6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to gambling."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.60.140 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9 (b) A person is guilty of a felony as specified in (c) of this
10 section if he

11 (1) extends credit or guarantees money to another person
12 engaged in playing a gambling game specified in (a) of this section;
13 or

14 (2) conducts or allows to be conducted, either as owner,
15 proprietor or employee, whether for hire or not, a gambling game speci-
16 fied in (a) of this section in which he knowingly permits the exten-
17 sion of credit or the guaranteeing of money by another to a player as
18 specified in this subsection; or

19 (3) is hired for or engages in or assists in the collection
20 of money or thing of monetary value with knowledge that it is in
21 payment for a debt incurred as a result of a loss in a gambling game.

22 (c) A person who violates (b) of this section is guilty of a
23 felony and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than
24 \$5,000, or by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than ten
25 years.
