6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to membership of borough planning  
7 commissions."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 29.33.080(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The borough planning commission consists of five residents  
11 unless a greater number is otherwise provided by ordinance. Commission  
12 membership shall be apportioned so that the number of members from  
13 first class cities reflects the proportion of borough population  
14 residing within those cities. Members shall be appointed by the  
15 borough executive for a term of three years subject to confirmation  
16 by the assembly, except that appointments of members from first class  
17 cities are made from the city advisory planning commission membership  
18 [SELECTED FROM A LIST OF RECOMMENDATIONS SUBMITTED BY THE CITY  
19 COUNCIL]. Members first appointed shall draw lots for one-, two- and  
20 three-year terms. Appointments to fill vacancies are for the  
21 unexpired term. The compensation and expenses of the planning  
22 commission and its staff are paid as directed by the assembly.
