6 For an Act entitled: "An Act expanding duties of Governor's Commission
7 on the Administration of Justice."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19.756 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.19.756. DUTIES OF STATE PLANNING AGENCY. (a) As the
11 state planning agency, the commission has the responsibility of
12 coordinating and planning in Alaska, the federal, state, and local
13 efforts under Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets
14 Act of 1968, as amended.

15 (b) The commission is authorized to investigate state and local
16 needs and seek funding for

17 (1) development of more effective crime prevention programs
18 and techniques;

19 (2) development of programs to aid the courts in the field
20 of criminal adjudication;

21 (3) development of programs to rehabilitate offenders and
22 prevent recidivism.

23 (c) The commission shall assist the planning and coordination
24 of criminal justice programs and personnel in the Department of Law,
25 Health and Social Services, and Public Safety and the public defender's
26 office.

27 (d) The commission shall prepare a five-year plan which projects
28 the necessary and advisable allocation, utilization, qualifications and
29 coordination of criminal justice personnel at the state and local level.

1 (e) In order to facilitate interagency communication and
2 cooperation, the commission shall hold interagency conferences for
3 the discussion and planning of law enforcement, crime prevention,
4 criminal adjudication and offender rehabilitation programs and
5 personnel for the Departments of Law, Health and Social Services,
6 and Public Safety, the public defender's office and the court.
