It may make studies relating to the incorporation it considers appropriate."

Page 2, line 15: delete "(e)" and insert "(f)"

Page 3, line 17: delete "accordance" and insert "substantial compliance"

Page 4, line 3: delete "of the regular" and substitute "one year preceding the next regular"

Page 4, line 19: delete "exercised" and substitute "exercise"

Page 5, line 2: after "as" insert "to"

Page 6, line 2: before "fiscal" insert "borough"

Page 6, line 10: delete "(d)"; combine language on lines 10 - 13 with (c); and re-letter the following subsections

Page 6, line 11: delete "(c) of this section" and substitute "this subsection"

Page 6, line 17: after the period insert the following new matter:  
"The provisions of this Act or other law notwithstanding, Greater Anchorage Area Borough assembly or school board members who are residents of the area which is incorporated as a borough under provisions of this Act continue to serve in office until completion of the transition under (c) of this section, and thereafter their seats on the assembly
